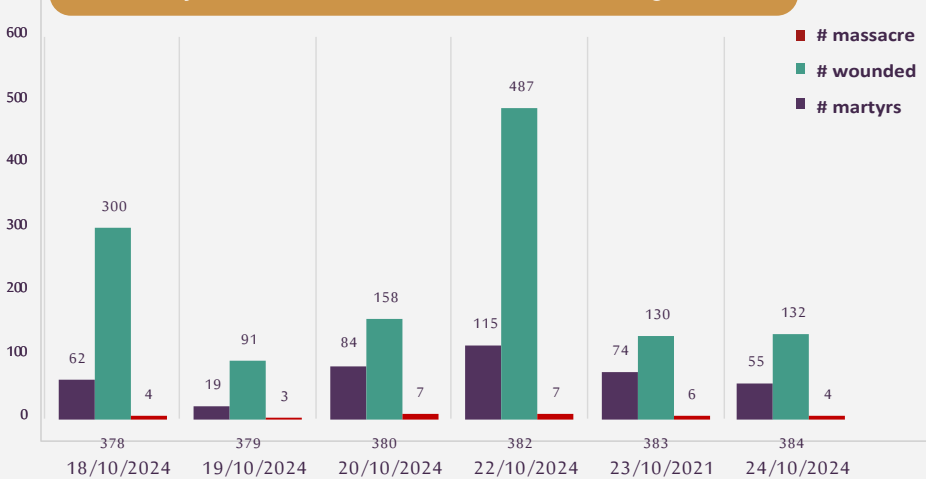

Significant Humanitarian Facts



UNRWA Commissioner-General Philippe Lazzarini indicated that the Gaza Strip is currently experiencing severe poverty, with its economic conditions reverting to those of 70 years ago as a result of the ongoing conflict.



OCHA spokesperson Jens Laerke stated that the Israeli occupation has denied all efforts to deliver humanitarian assistance to the northern Gaza Strip from October 2 to 15, preventing any food aid from reaching the region.



The Israeli occupation is hindering the execution of the emergency polio vaccination initiative, thereby denying children in the area their right to receive vaccinations.

- UNICEF has announced that the third phase of the polio vaccination campaign, which was set to commence on Wednesday, has been delayed due to rising violence and widespread displacement.
- The regional director of the World Health Organization for the Eastern Mediterranean reported that intense Israeli bombardment, mass displacement, and restricted access have postponed plans to immunize over 119,000 children in the northern region.

Risks threatening Gaza Strip



Only %40 of elderly people with health issues have access to the medications they desperately need, and as a result, many of them lose their lives as their nutritional health declines, they lose weight, and their psychosocial well-being deteriorates.



The number of individuals facing severe food insecurity is projected to nearly triple from November 2024 to April 2025. It is estimated that 60,000 children aged six to 59 months will become acutely malnourished in the upcoming year.



According to the most recent data from the Health Resources and Services Availability Monitoring System:

- %76 of partially operational hospitals in Gaza are lacking sufficient water supply.
- %94 of these hospitals are experiencing a shortage of sanitation facilities.
- %71 are unable to guarantee proper hand hygiene.
- %82 of hospitals do not have personal protective equipment (PPE), and all are deficient in maintaining adequate environmental hygiene standards.
