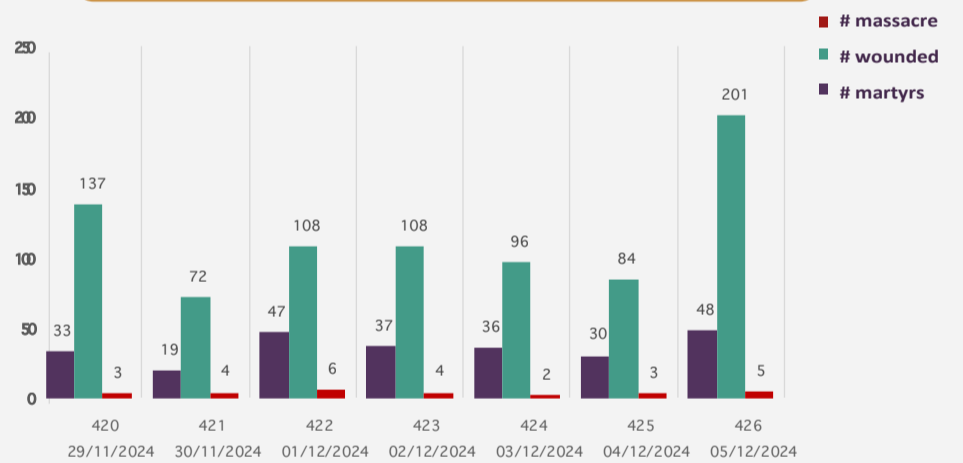

## Significant Humanitarian Facts



JUZ00R, an organization affiliated with Oxfam, continues its operations in northern Gaza and has reported that recent Israeli shelling targeted its shelter for displaced persons as well as its storage facility for food and medicine. This attack resulted in the destruction of equipment and the burning of medical supplies at the health point. (3)



In the town of Beit Lahia, located in the northern Gaza Strip, thousands of Palestinians have been compelled to evacuate after the Israeli army stormed the last shelter in the area. This situation has unfolded amid an ongoing military operation that was launched on October 5, exacerbating the suffering of citizens and intensifying the humanitarian crisis due to the escalating siege.



The volume of drinking water supplied to southern Gaza from Israel through two Mekorot pipelines has diminished from an average of 21,000 cubic meters per day to 14,000 cubic meters per day. Additionally, the provision of fuel necessary for the operation of water and sanitation facilities in the North Gaza governorate has been halted since October 4) (3) .2024 ,1)

## Risks threatening Gaza Strip



UNRWA reports that by the end of December 2024, a minimum of 60 types of medications will likely be depleted in its healthcare facilities. This includes 19 medications for mental health and non-communicable diseases, 17 antimicrobial and antiparasitic medications, and 8 medications for anti-inflammatory and gastrointestinal conditions. The water sector in Gaza has suffered damage exceeding %80, impacting wells, water pumping stations, desalination facilities, distribution networks, and wastewater treatment plants. Currently, only %19 of water wells are operational. (5)



If the current rate of medical evacuations persists, it will take seven years to facilitate the medical evacuation of 2,500 children in critical need, with some having already succumbed while awaiting necessary approvals. (6)
