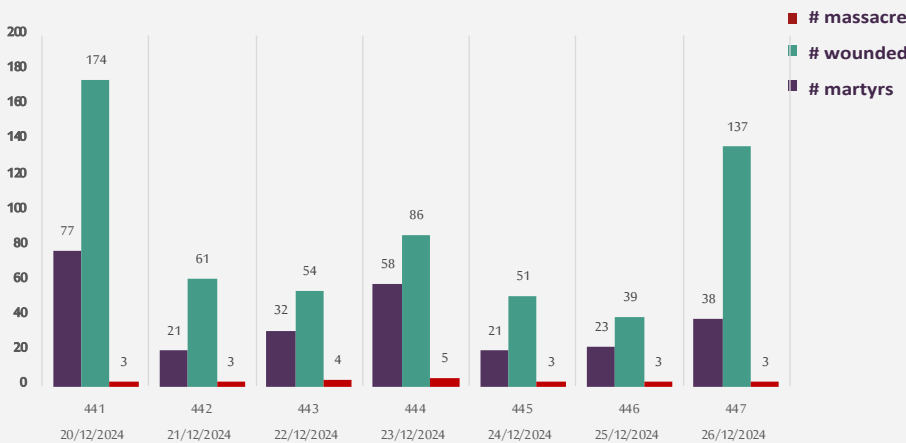

Significant Humanitarian Facts



On Thursday, Munir al-Borsh, the Director General of the Ministry of Health in Gaza, reported the tragic deaths of three Palestinian children in displacement tents over the course of a week, attributed to the severe cold temperatures amidst the ongoing Israeli aggression that has persisted for more than 14 months.



Between December 1 and December 15, the occupying forces permitted the entry of 1,213 humanitarian aid trucks into the Gaza Strip. This equates to a daily average of merely 81 trucks, significantly lower than the pre-crisis norm of 500 trucks per working day. (4)



The United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) has stated that a child is killed in the Gaza Strip every hour due to the ongoing war initiated by Israel over the past year. (3)

Risks threatening Gaza Strip



Certain regions within the North Gaza governorate have been subjected to a stringent blockade for over ten weeks, resulting in severely restricted access. This situation has left approximately 10,000 to 15,000 individuals without essential resources such as food, water, electricity, or dependable healthcare, while mass casualties continue to be reported. According to a report from OCHA, a study conducted by the War Child Coalition, utilizing data gathered in June 2024, reveals that 96% of children in the surveyed households perceive their death as imminent. Furthermore, it was found that at least one child in these households is either injured, disabled, unaccompanied, or separated from their parents. (4)



Humanitarian efforts directed towards the North Gaza governorate have faced significant disruptions, particularly those aimed at reaching Jabaliya, Beit Lahia, and Beit Hanoun. From December 1 to December 16, the United Nations made 40 attempts to access the besieged regions in northern Gaza; however, 38 of these attempts were completely denied, while the other two faced obstructions.
