Periodic Health Situation Report in the Gaza Strip – Report No .07

This report is issued by Medics WorldWide periodically (twice a month, on Mondays). It describes the health and humanitarian situation in the Gaza Strip, and it is based on statistics from the Ministry of Health, WHO, and the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Palestinian Affairs in the Occupied Palestinian Territory (OCHA)

Updates on the Humanitarian and Health Situation in the Gaza Strip

Children burned to death

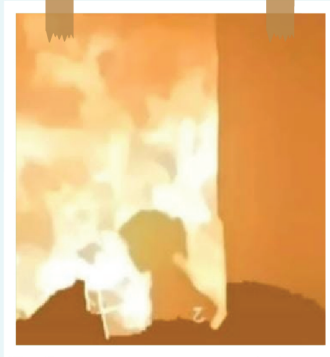
The Israeli occupation committed a horrific massacre against displaced civilians sheltering at the Fahmi Al-Jerjawi School in Al-Daraj neighbourhood, Gaza City, on May 26, 2025

According to Dr. Fadel Naeem, Director of Al-Ahli Arab (Baptist) Hospital in Gaza

1 20 bodies, bags filled with body parts, and around 50 wounded were received at the hospital following the bombing of Fahmi Al-Jerjawi School, which was housing displaced people in Al-Daraj neighbourhood.

2 The medical situation in the hospital is catastrophic. We were forced to transfer some of the injured to other hospitals due to our inability to accommodate all cases

3 We are currently performing emergency surgeries due to the severity of the injuries

The youngest humanitarian activist was martyred while extending a helping hand to children and planting hope in their hearts. Her body may be gone, but her legacy remains a beacon of humanity

Days, 600 The War on the Gaza Strip Continues for Over and Famine Deepens

United Nations: Gaza is the hungriest place on Earth

Humanitarian aid and flour have started entering Gaza under the control of the Israeli occupation, yet without allowing safe access to the population. There have been direct attacks on those attempting to ensure the aid reaches civilians—an explicit indication of the ongoing policy of systematic starvation against the people of Gaza and a blatant violation of international humanitarian law

World Central Kitchen Organisation:



- 1** We are currently **unable to deliver aid to Gaza**
- 2** The Israeli army allowed trucks to enter through the Kerem Shalom crossing, but they remain held
- 3** The Israeli army has not yet provided safe routes to deliver supplies to our kitchens



In an effort to alleviate the burden of hunger amid dire humanitarian conditions, **Medics** has been present among our people in Gaza, fulfilling its humanitarian duty with unwavering commitment by providing hot meals to displaced families, offering a small gesture of support in the ongoing journey of resilience and hope



60 children have died due to malnutrition, including Mohammed Mustafa Yassin (4 years old), who passed away at Al-Ahli Baptist Hospital in Gaza City as a result of the ongoing starvation campaign waged by the Israeli occupation against the Gaza Strip

The Massacres Continue — Is There Anyone to Help?

A massacre was committed against a displaced family sheltering under one roof in northern Gaza, resulting in the martyrdom of nearly **50 people**, including children, women, and the elderly. Survivors remain trapped under the rubble, while civil defence and ambulance crews are unable to reach them

”

The cycle of forced evacuation and displacement continues, as the Israeli occupation currently controls approximately **%75 of the Gaza Strip**.





The Reality of Primary Healthcare Centres in Gaza Strip

01

Stock levels of some medical equipment and medications in Gaza have reached “zero”

Only **30** primary healthcare centres are currently operational in the Gaza Strip **out of 105**

In May, **292** essential drug items were completely out of stock, representing a **%47** shortage. **649** types of medical consumables were also out of stock, reflecting a **%65** shortage

51 medical aid trucks are awaiting permits to enter Gaza but have not yet been granted access through the crossings

The basic services provided by the Ministry of Health are suffering from an unprecedented shortage of medications and medical supplies.

This shortage has affected: Primary healthcare services, Surgical operations and intensive care, Cancer and haematology care, Maternal and child health services, Orthopaedic surgery, nephrology, dialysis, ophthalmic surgery, and intensive care consumables

There is a severe shortage of IV fluids, syringes, and bandages, which hampers surgical treatments such as fracture anaesthesia

Medication and Supply Availability: Only **44** drug items (**%7** of essential medicines) are available in quantities sufficient for **1 to 3 months**. Just **61** items of medical consumables (**%6**) are available for the same duration.

Essential medications, including antibiotics, painkillers, and drugs for chronic illnesses, are available in minimal quantities

Financial Cost: The monthly financial cost of the **zero**-stock medication shortage is estimated at **1,719,433\$**, covering **%51** of the monthly need. For medical consumables, the estimated monthly shortfall amounts to **484,670\$**, covering **%57** of the required supply.

received the charred remains of her **9** children at Nasser Hospital, following a brutal Israeli airstrike. Her husband, a doctor, has died due to his injury. The news is over!

On Tuesday, **May 27.2025**, the Palestinian Red Crescent Society evacuated **7** injured individuals and **54** medical personnel and companions from Al-Awda and the Indonesian Hospitals in northern Gaza.

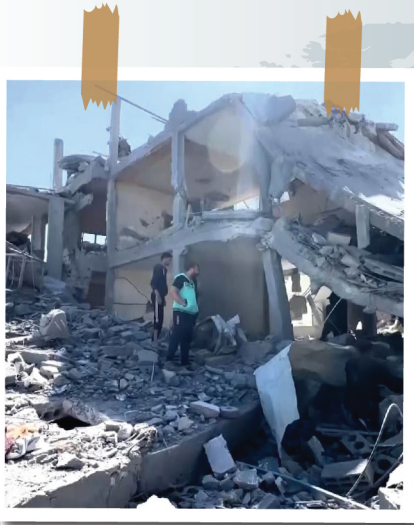
The Society reported that the evacuation took place under extremely dangerous conditions due to ongoing bombardment and severe restrictions on movement around the hospitals

In a harrowing violation of humanity, **1,581** healthcare workers have been killed during the ongoing genocide in Gaza, targeted while fulfilling their sacred duty: **saving lives**.

The Reality of Hospitals in Gaza Strip



Noura Al Kaabi Dialysis Hospital in the northern Gaza Strip was blown up by the Israeli Occupation



The occupation forces are demanding the evacuation of Al-Awda Hospital in the northern Gaza Governorate, forcibly taking it out of service after it was burned and directly targeted by quadcopter drones, resulting in injuries to **3** medical staff members working inside the hospital. This hospital was the only one still operating in northern Gaza.

World Health Organisation:

%94 of Gaza Strip hospitals have been damaged, leaving only **16 out of 38 hospitals** functioning partially.



The Red Cross Field Hospital remains under fire from the occupation forces.



On the morning of May 2025 ,28, the Red Cross Field Hospital in Mawasi, Khan Younis Governorate, was subjected to gunfire by the occupation forces, resulting in injuries and panic among patients and visitors inside the hospital

The need to produce double the amount of oxygen in hospital departments has increased, especially in intensive care units, operating rooms, neonatal wards, and emergency departments.

25 out of 34 oxygen stations were completely destroyed during the hospital invasions

Only 9 stations remain partially operational, which is insufficient to meet patient needs.

The ministry warns of catastrophic moments threatening the provision of medical care if the remaining oxygen stations stop functioning or fail.

The Ministry of Health urgently calls on all relevant parties to work swiftly to deliver oxygen stations



22 hospitals out of 38 have been taken out of service

Only 49 generators out of 110 are operational in Gaza hospitals, urgently needing maintenance and fuel

Only 50 operating rooms are currently functioning under catastrophic conditions, out of a total of 104

12 CT scanners have been destroyed out of 19

7 MRI machines were completely destroyed, leaving Gaza Strip without any diagnostic MRI devices

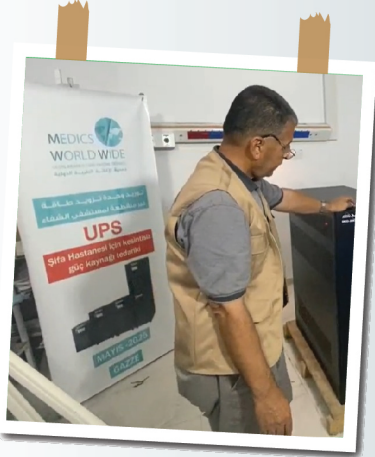
%41 of kidney failure patients have died during the war.

25 oxygen stations were destroyed out of 34, leaving only 9 partially functioning stations

Bed occupancy rates exceed %106

There is a severe shortage of medical imaging devices

Medics in the Field Alleviate the Pain



At a critical moment, during an unexpected power outage that lasted for **20** minutes in the intensive care unit at Al-Shifa Hospital, during which vital devices stopped working, the lives of many patients hung by a thread of hope. Medics did not delay in responding, quickly providing a backup power system (**UPS**) for this sensitive unit, which they had previously refurbished, to ensure the uninterrupted operation of medical devices. This was not merely a technical response but a humanitarian stance full of responsibility, aimed at protecting lives and ensuring continued care in the most vulnerable and needy moments

The intensity of fire and repeated targeting of Al-Aqsa European Hospital and its surroundings over the past several days have prevented the evacuation of many trapped medical staff working inside the hospital

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced the suspension of intravenous chemotherapy and medical follow-up services for cancer patients in the Strip, pointing out that the evacuation of the European Hospital in the southern Gaza Strip and the Gaza Cancer Centre has exacerbated the catastrophic situation for patients

02

There are **11,000** cancer patients in Gaza without proper treatment and healthcare, and 5,000 cancer patients urgently referred abroad either for diagnosis or chemotherapy and radiotherapy treatment

03

The lack of early diagnostic and follow-up devices leads to the worsening health conditions of patients, with **%64** of cancer medications unavailable



The Reality of Referrals of Patients

477 patients awaiting travel for treatment abroad have died

Between 12,000 and 14,000 patients in Gaza are in urgent need of specialised medical care outside the Strip

Only one rescue vehicle belonging to the Civil Defence is operational in the northern Gaza Strip, while the intensity of attacks exceeds the capacity of the current teams

These heartbreaking numbers not only represent innocent lives lost but also reflect the magnitude of the humanitarian catastrophe and the depth of the crime committed against an entire generation that was supposed to be protected, cared for, and educated, not turned into targets for airstrikes and tank shells

Pregnant women in Gaza give birth to babies with frail and low-weight bodies due to maternal malnutrition, caused by the ongoing closure of crossings and the prevention of essential food and medication from reaching pregnant women during pregnancy



The United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) warns that "pregnant and breastfeeding women are fighting a daily battle to survive



Only seven hospitals and four field hospitals continue to provide maternity and newborn care in Gaza, while facing a severe shortage of essential supplies, with more than half of the basic medicines for mothers and newborns depleted as of May 20



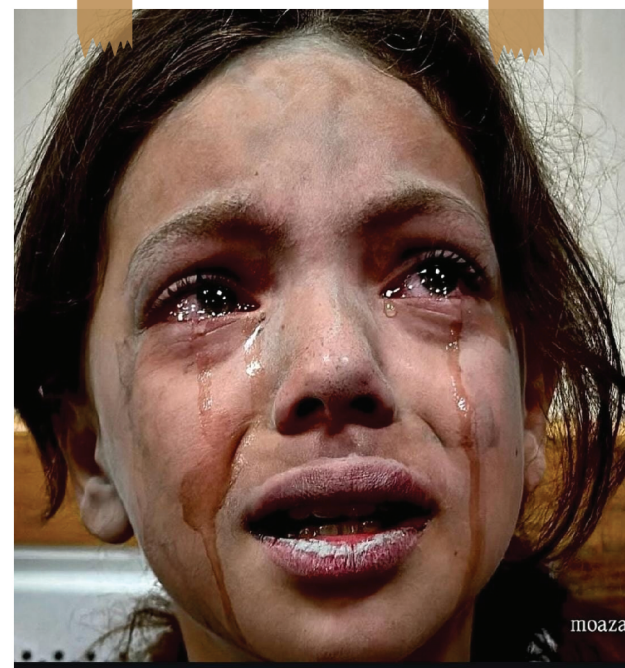
Currently, one in every three pregnancies is considered high-risk, and one in every five newborns is born prematurely or suffers from low birth weight, requiring specialised care that is increasingly unavailable, while access to basic services has become severely restricted



Amid these harsh conditions, reports indicate that nearly **11,000** pregnant women are already at risk of famine, and approximately **17,000** pregnant women will require urgent treatment for severe malnutrition in the coming months



The Reality of Psychological Health and Education



%95 of educational facilities have been destroyed or damaged.

Approximately 788,000 students have been deprived of education for the second consecutive year

The only mental health hospital in Gaza sustained direct damage, leading to a complete halt of its specialised services

%80 of Gaza's population suffers from symptoms of post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), chronic anxiety, or depression, according to humanitarian organisations' estimates

Schools that have been converted into shelters have been directly targeted, exacerbating the loss of a sense of security among children and women
